If you take your donations to the parish as a tax deduction then we ask that you use the envelope system or join in the direct deposit program ParishPay which we offer. ## Pilgrimage to the Holy Land with Fr. David Michael

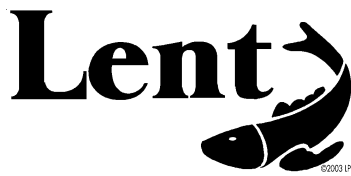

- Fast from discontent *Feast on gratitude*
- Fast from anger *Feast on patience*
- Fast from pessimism *Feast on optimism*
- Fast from worry *Feast on Divine Order*
